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

What is the LGIP?

The New Mexico Local Government Investment Pool (LGIP) is a short-term investment fund managed by the State Treasurer's Office (STO) and made available to local governments ("participants") throughout the State.

The LGIP is professionally managed and directly invests in safe and highly liquid bond and cash investments. This structure enables the LGIP to provide an attractive short-term investment option while providing the freedom to deposit and withdraw funds, without penalty, based upon your own cash needs. 
Why Invest in the LGIP?

- Liquidity—Withdrawal requests up to \$30 million are processed within one business day.
- Return—The LGIP's low-cost structure allows us to pass on more earnings to our participants.
- Oversight—LGIP investment activity is reported to (and overseen by) the State Treasurer's Investment Committee. Monthly reporting is also disclosed via STO's website.
